Dear Chairwoman Lofgren,

I would like to take this opportunity to further amend my 2009 Financial Disclosure Statement.

The following transactions should have been listed on Schedule IV:

- Shares of Vanguard Sector Index FDS Vanguard Fnls Vipers in the amount of \$50,000-\$100,000 were PURCHASED on 2/20/09.
- Shares of Wisdom Tree Intl Small Cap Dividend Fund in the amount of \$50,000-\$100,000 were PURCHASED on 8/11/09.
- Shares of Sector Industrial SPDR in the amount of \$50,001 - \$100,000 were PURCHASED on 8/12/09.
- Shares of Western Union in the amount of \$1,000 - \$15,000 were SOLD on 10/21/09.
- Shares of 3M in the amount of \$15,000 - \$50,000 were PURCHASED on 11/23/09.

The follow adjustments should also be made:

- The "Vanguard Total Bond Fund Ind" transaction listed on Schedule IV was a duplicative listing and should therefore be stricken from the report, as it was also listed under "Vanguard Bond Index Fund Total Market" with the same purchase information. It was properly listed on Schedule III with reportable dividends once under the asset "Vanguard Bond Index Fund Total Market".
- The transaction listed on Schedule IV for "Rydex S&P Equal Weight Financial" should be deleted as that purchase was made in the National Financial Services IRA account which is listed as a whole in Schedule III.
- "Fidelity Spartan International Index" and "Spartan Intl Index Investor Class" are the same asset but were inadvertently listed under different titles. All references to either should be corrected to read "Fidelity Spartan International Index" on both Schedules III and IV.
- On Schedule VII, one trip should have been reported. The trip was funded by the American Israel Education Foundation and took place from August 8-16, 2009. The trip departed from Washington, DC with a destination of Tel Aviv, Israel, and then returned to Washington, DC. Expenses for lodging and food were covered. There were no family members included, nor were there additional days spent at the location that were not at the sponsor's expense.

Thank you for allowing me to submit these corrections and clarifications.
