    WHEREAS, the United States Supreme Court has interpreted the

    WHEREAS, the United States Supreme Court has interpreted

of the mother, although not required to prevent the death of the
mother; and
WHFREAS, these internretations have thrust concepts upon the citizens of this nation which were never confronted by our forefathers in drafting the oriqinal document, and which massive numbers of persons, including the citizens of this state, find
repulsive to the American way of life;
    NON, THEREFDRE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the 42nd Leqislature of
the state of Utah respectfully applies to the conqress of the
United states to call a convention for the purpose of drafting
and sutmmitiny for ratification by the states, as provided by
Article V of the Constitution of the United States, an amendment
