University of Houston Awarded \$179,988 NSF Grant for Groundbreaking Scientific Data Analysis Research

Washington, D.C. - The Office of the 18th Congressional District of Texas is proud to announce that the University of Houston has been awarded \$179,988 in federal funding from the National Science Foundation (NSF) for a research project in scientific data analysis. This grant underscores the university's commitment to advancing scientific knowledge and innovation both locally and globally.

The project, titled "Collaborative Research: Elements: SGCC: An Efficient GPU-oriented Data Reduction Cyberinfrastructure for Scientific Data Analysis," is led by Principal Investigator Jinyang Liu and will begin on August 1, 2025. The research focuses on developing a GPU-based system to improve the efficiency of scientific data reduction and analysis, addressing challenges in processing large-scale data.
