

Office of the At Large Congressional District of North Dakota to Serve Constituents under the Supervision of the Office of the Clerk

PRESS RELEASE

Washington, DC—The office of former Representative Kelly Armstrong will continue to serve the people of the At Large Congressional District of North Dakota under the supervision of the Clerk of the House of Representatives. Representative Armstrong resigned December 14, 2024.

Please note that the office will be closed from December 23, 2024, through January 2, 2025, and will reopen January 3, 2025.

Under House Rules, the Clerk manages vacant offices and their staff after a Member dies, resigns, or is expelled. This authority, which does not include voting representation, continues until a successor is elected to fill the vacant seat. The Acting Clerk of the House is Kevin F. McCumber. This is the sixteenth vacancy to occur during the 118th Congress. Nineteen vacancies occurred in the 117th Congress.

Representative-elect Julie Fedorchak will take the oath of office to serve the At Large Congressional District of North Dakota for the 119th Congress on January 3, 2025. Requests for further details should be directed to the Office of the Clerk (202) 225-7000.
