SBA Disaster Loans Available for Shasta County After December Storms

Washington, D.C.—The U.S. Small Business Administration (SBA) has [declared](#) a disaster following the December 16–26, 2025 winter storms, making low-interest federal disaster loans available to residents, businesses, and nonprofits in Shasta County and surrounding counties.

Eligible applicants may apply for:

- **Business Physical Disaster Loans** of up to \$2 million to repair or replace storm-damaged property, equipment, and inventory.
- **Economic Injury Disaster Loans (EIDL)** for small businesses, agricultural cooperatives, nurseries, and private nonprofits that lost revenue due to the storms, even if they did not suffer physical damage.
- **Home Disaster Loans** for homeowners and renters. Homeowners may borrow up to \$500,000 to repair a primary residence and up to \$100,000 for personal property. Renters may apply for up to \$100,000 for personal property losses.

A temporary Disaster Loan Outreach Center is open in Redding at 777 Cypress Avenue, Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Walk-ins are welcome, and appointments may be scheduled in advance at appointment.sba.gov.

The deadline to apply for physical damage assistance is April 6. The deadline for economic injury applications is November 3.
